

HOUSERULES SUMMERSTAGE ORGANISOR: SPOT GRONINGEN

(Version 17-02-2025)

General Access Rules

1. These house rules apply to everyone present at the Summerstage venue.
2. During a visit to Summerstage, the terms and conditions of an event organizer may also apply. These conditions may supplement the house rules of Summerstage but do not replace them.
3. These house rules apply to everyone who uses the event site and the parking lot and other associated locations (the "Location"). This contributes to a safe environment and pleasant experience for all visitors.
4. Here you will find guidelines on what you can and cannot bring to the event. Are you unsure about an item? There's a good chance it's not allowed. The organizer offer no storage options, so only take what you really need.
3. Always follow the instructions of the organizer's team or those given by them designated employees. They are there to keep everything running smoothly and safely expired.
4. In unforeseen situations for which these house rules do not provide, the organizer retains reserves the right to take additional measures.

Self-reliance, Own Risk & Liability

5. Make sure you are aware of the escape routes in the event of an emergency.
6. If necessary, the organizer can decide to evacuate the location.
7. Make sure you are always available for emergencies.
8. Access to the location and participation in the event is at your own risk. The organizer is not liable for damage or injury, such as hearing or vision problems and/or other physical damage.
9. Noise levels can exceed 80 dB(A). The use of hearing protection is recommended and is your own responsibility
10. Spending the night on or around the location is not permitted and can be enforced by the police.

Minimum age

11. The organizer advises visitors under the age of 16 to attend the event accompanied by an adult. Everyone, regardless of age, has one valid ticket required.

12. A minimum age may apply for certain events, which will be stated in advance website of the organizer is communicated.

Identification obligation

13. Just like everywhere else in the Netherlands, identification is required during the event. Always bring a valid ID (driving license, passport or identity card).

14. At the request of security, bar staff or other authorized employees, you must be able to show a valid ID.

Accessibility and Medical Assistance

15. The organizer offers extra facilities for visitors with disabilities. See above www.summerstage.nl.

16. Chairs and stools are not permitted. If you have a medical need, please contact us in advance via info@spotgroningen.nl.

17. Wheelchairs, walkers and other medical aids are permitted, but can be restricted in certain areas for safety reasons.

18. Medication may only be taken with a medicine passport or a current one medication overview. The medical service can check this.

19. Necessary food or drinks due to allergies or illness are permitted with a medical certificate from, for example, a GP, dietitian or a card from your patient association.

Access and Security

20. You can only gain access to the location with a valid admission ticket.

21. Re-entering the Location is not possible once you have it to leave.

22. Stay within the areas you have access to and do not stand on bleacher steps.

23. The organizer reserves the right to deny visitors access without any right on compensation.

24. Photos and video recordings can be taken during the event promotional purposes, without compensation.

Security check

26. Visitors are obliged to cooperate with security checks such as searches and inspection of personal property.

27. Refusal of checks may lead to denial of entry without entitlement refund.

28. There is camera surveillance on and around the location for the safety of visitors and staff.

Rules of conduct

29. (Sexual) intimidation, aggression, discrimination, destruction and nuisance are not permitted tolerated and may lead to removal and involvement of the police.

30. Crowdsurfing, graffiti, making fire, vandalism, climbing structures and similar activities are prohibited.

31. Wearing football shirts, club-related or provocative expressions and face-covering clothing is not permitted.

Own food and drinks

32. Bringing your own food and drinks is not permitted, with the exception of medical supplies. Drinking bottles, water bottles or similar, glasses, tin, hard plastic and/or metal bottles are not allowed.

Alcohol, Smoking and Drugs

33. Alcohol and tobacco are not sold to persons under the age of 18. Pass it on to minors is also prohibited in line with Dutch law.

34. (Electronic) smoking is only allowed in the open air, not in tents or under canopies.

35. Drugs and mind-altering substances, including laughing gas, are not permitted

Forbidden Objects

36. Objects such as aerosol cans (with the exception of small packages up to 250 ml sunscreen, deodorant and perfume), tin, glass, needles, weapons, chains or other objects that can be used as weapons or can disrupt the order, fireworks, flares, laser pointers and other light with a focused beam, bicycles, skates, skateboards, scooters, unmanned aerial vehicles (so-called UAV or Drones), (domestic) animals. Laptops, e-readers, tablets/lpads, speakers, walkie-talkies, toxic, flammable, explosive materials and/or other dangerous objects, selfie sticks, banners, cardboard/paper signs with inscription larger than A4 size, flags or flagpoles are not permitted.

37. Large bags and backpacks (larger than A4 and thicker than 10 cm incl. front and side pockets) are not allowed.

38. Umbrellas are not allowed and are not taken into custody.

Recordings and Commercial Activities

39. Professional photo, film and other recording equipment is not permitted without it prior consent. Think of SLR cameras, cameras with detachable lenses and GoPro or similar equipment)

40. Commercial or influencer content without the approval of the organizer prohibited and may lead to legal action.

41. It is not permitted to sell goods or flyers/samples without permission to distribute.

Parking rules

42. Parking is at your own risk. The organizer is not liable for damage or theft.

43. Only passenger cars and motorcycles are allowed. Spending the night on it parking is not allowed.

44. Follow instructions from parking staff to ensure safety.

Respect for neighbors and environment

45. Use designated parking and sanitary facilities.

46. Take local residents into account by not causing any nuisance.

47. Throw waste in the appropriate bins.

Violation of the House Rules

48. In the event of violation of the house rules, access may be denied without any right to compensation refund.
